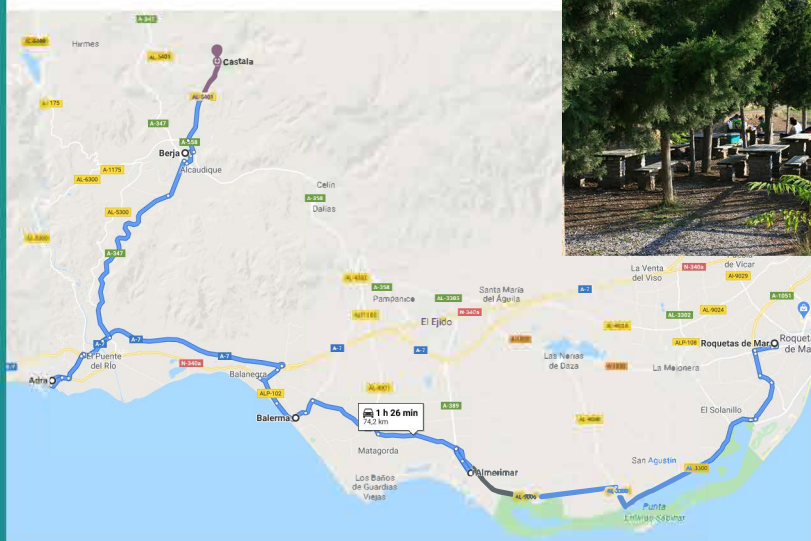

ROQUETAS DE MAR – ALMERIMAR – EL EJIDO – ADRA – BERJA – CASTALA

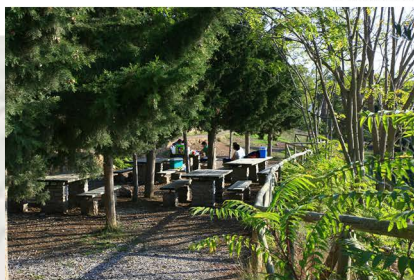
We travel from Roquetas towards Almerimar bordering the ponds of the salt flats. Before visiting the Natural Reserve of Punta Entinas and Punta Sabinal; in the park, there are small ponds that serve as a refuge for hundreds of water birds: flamingos, red ducks, gray herons etc. Of course you must do this area on foot.

The road to Almerimar follows its course, flanked by two rows of greenhouses. Within walking distance is Almerimar, a luxurious development with its wonderful golf course and marina. We continue to El Ejido, an important town in the province with a sea of greenhouses. We continue for about 12 km to Adra, a fishing town whose inhabitants are dedicated almost equally to agriculture, fishing and commerce. The port of Adra is the oldest in the province, bordering the Granada province. We now go direction Berja, for which we have to ascend about 14 km along a regional road. We enter La Alpujarra. The most notable feature of Berja is its central square, the church and the Town Hall.

If you still have time you can pay a visit to Castala, 5 km away, in the heart of the Sierra de Gádor. Breathing in that air will give you new vitality. We can go back to Roquetas de Mar through Dalías and El Ejido.
