Duration: 1 Day Distance: 103 km.












## BERJA – ALCOLEA – LAUJAR DE ANDARAX – FONDON – PADULES – CANJAYAR - INSTINCION - TERQUE - ENIX

We enter one of the most peculiar and characteristic regions of Almería. They are small towns, most of which do not reach a thousand inhabitants, in continuous struggle against a hostile soil and nature. Essentially agricultural towns. You will love this bouquet of small villages hanging from the Sierras Nevada and Gádor. Its whiteness surrounded by the green of the field that gives them life, will make you stop to take photos. You can access this route in two ways: from Berja or the other end from Énix.

Must visit: Laujar de Andarax, the capital of the Alpujarras, famous for its typical pink wine.

After so much up and down, (32 km), a break will come in handy, make a stop in any of these small town and try some local tapa bars, you will love it. You can now take the highway and return to Roquetas.
